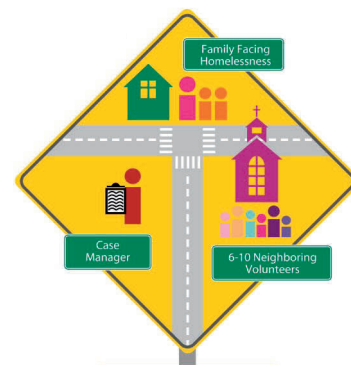


Neighboring Volunteers
