

Katie's Journey

In September 2019, I found myself on the sidewalk outside of a family member's house with all of our belongings, waiting for a shelter to call me back. Thankfully, my stepsister invited us to stay for a couple of months until I figured out my next move. I was working part-time and could barely afford to give her the \$300 rent she was asking for. I knew I had to find help fast because I had a deadline until my daughter and I were homeless again. I reached out to multiple shelters but all were at capacity. I eventually came across Bridge of Hope BuxMont and thought, "I doubt they're going to get back to me but it's worth a shot." It costs a lot of pride to reach out and admit you need help. I felt like I failed as a mother and was a lost cause. But I am extremely glad I reached out.

Fast forward to February 2020 and I moved into an apartment. Then I was connected to a job in through a Bridge of Hope donor and was able to start school to become a licensed esthetician. I graduated in January 2021 and started working full time in that field. In February, I moved into a new larger apartment with six months of rent down. If you had told me I would have accomplished all of those things back when I was on the sidewalk, I would have looked at you like you were crazy.

None of that would have been possible if I didn't have the help I got from Bridge of Hope BuxMont.

I learned many life skills from this program including how to obtain a car, get my credit score up and more. I feel more prepared to live on my own, which is a great feeling. I no longer feel stuck in this hole of not knowing how I'm going to pay my bills or take care of my daughter. This goes to show that it is okay to reach out and ask for help; imagine where I would be if I didn't. I am forever grateful for the community at Bridge of Hope BuxMont for never giving up on me!


