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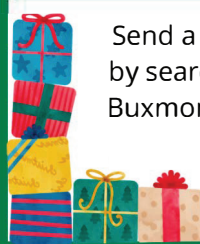

We are on our way to serving a record high, in one fiscal year, of over 70 women & children and your support has been the difference for each one! We are thankful for every partner – whether small or large – that has invested in providing empowerment, opportunities and most of all HOPE!

BUT there is more work to be done. In the midst of an extremely difficult rental housing market, low availability of units and the climbing costs of just about everything – Bridge of Hope BuxMont experienced a 188% increase in phone calls for help when compared to the same six month period just last year!

We need to grow to meet these calls for help within our community. We are adding two positions to our team to increase and expand our ability to respond. Will you join us affecting change – one mother, one child at a time?

We've seen the strength and courage it takes to battle homelessness and hold a family together. We know that when a families' basic needs, like housing are met, and they have people walking alongside them - they can start to build resiliency with confidence that they are not alone. It takes time to heal and rebuild but that's when the transformation happens from surviving to thriving! Because of your involvement, we witnessed an amazing transformation in one of our moms that graduated in June:

"I found myself facing the unthinkable. My children's father backed out of all of his responsibilities as a parent and my children and I became homeless. I was working full-time and still could not afford a home for us. Then the pandemic happened and it was even more of a strain. I had to stop working to home school my children, especially because of my son's health issues that put him at high risk. My vehicle died. A family member stored all of our belonging but ended up throwing them in a dumpster. We ended up with nothing. I was feeling broken and hopeless. I was determined to keep going for my children but felt defeated.



The Bridge of Hope program was very helpful as I slowly began to reconstruct a life for my children and myself. It helped to create healthy habits and accountability. The encouragement I received throughout this journey helped me see for myself that I can regain stability for us and when I doubted myself, my case manager helped me see all that I was accomplishing. There were some bumps in the journey but we got a fresh start! We have a new home that is safe from fighting! We are continuing to make new memories. We have stability and safety. I have a reliable car. I have a good job that is close to home and I have made new friends that care about my children. We are better and stronger because of the BOH program. I am HAPPY, CONFIDENT and on a steady track moving forward in every aspect of my life."
